
Greeting from Christians to Muslims!

This Gospel says:

"For whosoever shall keep the whole law, and yet offend in one point, he is guilty of all." (Holy Injeel, James 2:10)

But: *"The heart is deceitful above all things, and desperately wicked; who can know it?"* (Jeremiah 17:9)

And: "There is a way that seems right unto a man, but the end thereof are the ways of death." (Proverbs 16:25)

"All we like sheep have gone astray, we have turned everyone to his own way; and the LORD has laid on him the iniquity of us all". (Isaiah 53:6)

God is a holy and just judge who says,

"The wages of sin is death".

(Romans 6:23)

WHAT SHOULD WE DO?

In the Torah, we read that two brothers, the sons of Adam, brought their **offerings** to God. One offered a lamb as God said, and his offering was *accepted*.

The other brother's offering was *not accepted* because it was not what God required. He was angry because God did not accept his offering, and he killed his brother!

THE FIDYA

When God tested Ibrahim, God provided a **ram** in place of Ibrahim's son.

"O Ibrahim...We ransomed [fidya] him with a great sacrifice." (Sura 37:107)

The ram was the ransom for Ibrahim's son; and Jesus is the promised "**great sacrifice**" who said that he "*came not to be ministered unto, but to minister, and to give his life a ransom* [**fidya**] *for many.*"

(Mark 10:45)

"There is one God, and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus, who gave himself a **ransom** for all."

(I Timothy 2:5,6)

Perhaps you say, "God is merciful so He might forgive". God is a just judge. How can He forgive if we try to please Him by our prayers, fasting, giving but we reject His priceless **ransom** (**fidya**) for our sins? Justice is not served. We become like the man who did not bring the offering God required. Ibrahim's son had to die—or the ram.

You say that you believe in Isa (Jesus). Then consider the clear Gospel message, unchanged from Muhammad's time: "[Jesus] *Christ died for our sins according to the scriptures* [The Holy Injeel]... *he was buried, and that He rose again the third day....*" (1 Corinthians 15:3,4)

Ask God to show you if Jesus is God's accepted fidya for your sin.
